

**NOTICE OF SPECIAL ELECTION FOR THE CITY OF PLAINVIEW
FOR THE RECALL OF JULIE CORNETT, PLAINVIEW CITY COUNCIL MEMBER**

Public Notice is hereby given to all qualified electors of Plainview City, Pierce County, in the State of Nebraska, that a special recall election has been called pursuant to a petition filed in the Office of the Pierce County Clerk/Election Commissioner and will be held in said Political Subdivision on Tuesday, the 12th day of November, 2019, at which time there shall be submitted to the qualified electors of said Subdivision the following proposition:

“Shall Julie Cornett be removed from the Office of Plainview City Council?

YES

NO

All legal electors of Plainview City voting in favor of the recall shall completely blacken the oval opposite the word “YES”, and all legal electors of Plainview City voting against the recall shall completely blacken the oval opposite the word “NO”.

This election complies with the requirements of State Statute §32-952 to be held by mail and the Secretary of State has granted permission to hold the election by mail. Therefore, there will be no polling site on the day of the election.

Ballots will be mailed to the registered address of each qualified elector between the dates of October 28, 2019 and November 1, 2019 by non-forwardable first class mail.

Ballots may be returned by mail (the brown envelope for mailing is self-addressed to the Clerk), directly placed by voter or agent in the secured locked ballot box at the Plainview City Clerk’s Office at 209 W. Locust Street, Plainview, NE, until 5:00 p.m. on Election Day, Tuesday, November 12, 2019, or returned to the County Clerk’s Office in-person or by agent at 111 W. Court Street, Room 1, Pierce, NE. The voted ballot must be in the possession of the Pierce County Clerk by 5:00 P.M. on Election Day, Tuesday, November 12, 2019.

If a qualified elector wishes to receive an early voting ballot prior to the dates listed above the ballots are to be mailed, one may be obtained from the Pierce County Clerk in Pierce, Nebraska, and voted as provided by law. The Clerk may be contacted at 111 W. Court Street, Rm 1, Pierce, NE 68767; by phone at 402-329-4225 or by e-mail at piecoclk@ptcnet.net. Office hours are Monday through Friday from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., excluding holidays. An Early Voter Application will be running in the Plainview News once ballots are available.

Deadlines to register to vote for this election are as follows: By mail, delivery, or outside agency including the DMV or County Treasurer through October 25, 2019; in person at the County Clerk’s Office not later than 6:00 P.M. on Friday, November 1, 2019 to vote in this Special Recall Election.

Since the ballots will be mailed to the registrant’s address, all registrants should be sure that they are registered at their current and correct address by checking with the County Clerk or on the Secretary of State website at www.votercheck.necvr.ne.gov
