

Public Notice

Notice is hereby given to residents of Plainview City, Pierce County, NE that the **last day to register to vote for the November 12, 2019 Special Recall Election for the City of Plainview Council Member Julie Cornett is Friday, November 1, 2019 at 6:00 p.m. in person and in the office of the Pierce County Clerk/Election Commissioner.** All persons wishing to vote must be a United States citizen, Nebraska resident and at least 18 years of age, or 17 years of age, and reach the age of 18 on or before the first Tuesday, after the first Monday in November of this year, that being Tuesday, November 5, 2019. Eligible applicants must complete a Nebraska Voter Registration Application providing: their name; residence and postal address; party affiliation or indication of no affiliation; a valid Nebraska's driver's license number or the last four digits of their social security number and their signature.

THERE IS NO POLLING PLACE FOR THE ABOVE SAID ELECTION AND BALLOTS SHOULD HAVE BEEN RECEIVED BY THOSE REGISTERED QUALIFIED ELECTORS. IF YOU HAVE NOT RECEIVED A BALLOT AND THOUGHT YOU SHOULD HAVE CONTACT THE COUNTY CLERK'S OFFICE.

Ballots may be returned by mail (the brown envelope for mailing is self-addressed to the Clerk), directly placed by voter or agent in the secured locked ballot box at the Plainview City Clerk's office at 209 W. Locust Street, Plainview, NE until 5:00 p.m. on Election Day, Tuesday, November 12, 2019, or returned to the County Clerk's Office in-person or by agent at 111 W. Court Street, Room 1, Pierce, NE. The voted ballot must be in the possession of the Pierce County Clerk by 5:00 P.M. on Election Day, Tuesday, November 12, 2019. **PLEASE MAKE SURE THE VOTERS OATH IS COMPLETED AND SIGNED ON THE BACKSIDE OF THE BROWN BALLOT ENVELOPE, IF THE OATH IS NOT SIGNED AND COMPLETED THE CLERK WILL NOT BE ABLE TO COUNT THE VOTE.**
