SPECIAL ISSUES FOR PIERCE CITY ISSUE #1

CITY OF PIERCE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM

The terms, conditions and goals of the proposed Economic Development Program are as follows:

- A. The goals of the program are to retain existing jobs by assisting with the succession of businesses; doing what is necessary to keep our downtown vital; to advance and assist with educational programs which promote youth entrepreneurship in order to encourage hometown business start-up; to assist with existing business expansion; to create jobs/generate employment opportunities; increase households in the City of Pierce; to broaden the tax base; to attract new capital investment to the community and establish stability and vitality for the community of Pierce and the surrounding area.
B. Funds for the program may be used for purchasing real estate or options for real estate, developing small businesses and expansions thereof, recruiting quality businesses into the area, investing equity in qualifying businesses, creating a revolving loan fund, and conducting other economic development activities allowable under Nebraska Law determined to be beneficial to the City of Pierce.
C. The Economic Development Program approved by the City Council has provisions allowing the City of Pierce to issue bonds pursuant to the Local Option Municipal Economic Development Act to provide funding for the program.
D. The program shall commence April 1, 2023 and end April 1, 2038.
E. Collection of funds shall begin on April 1, 2023 and end April 1, 2038.
F. The source from which funds are to be collected shall be from a 1/2% City Local Option Sales Tax
G. The total amount to be collected from the local sources of revenue for the Economic Development Program will be approximately \$125,000 per year over a 15-year period for an approximate total of \$1,875,000.
