

PRESS RELEASE FROM PIERCE COUNTY

Beginning Tuesday, March 24, 2020 Pierce County will be conducting business in a modified manner to comply with COVID-19 social distancing guidelines recommended by Federal and State agencies. All Pierce County offices will be open for business via phone call; email and regular mail. If a matter cannot be resolved remotely, please contact the office you need to do business with, and make an appointment so that your matter can be resolved. You must call or email ahead for an appointment as the doors of the Pierce County Courthouse will be locked and access will only be granted to those who have called or emailed ahead for a scheduled appointment time. We encourage all people who need services to access these online or over the phone if possible.

The regularly scheduled Pierce County Board of Commissioners' meetings which are currently scheduled for April 6 and April 20, etc. will go on as scheduled with the Public having access through Facebook Live video conferencing. Within the public notice for the upcoming Board meetings it will state how the Public can access the meetings.

County Court and District Court will continue as scheduled at this time. Please call prior to your scheduled court time to verify if changes have been made since adjustments may occur rapidly. Both court offices will limit entry into courtrooms to only individuals who must appear.

The State of Nebraska has cancelled all Drivers License testing until further notice. Drivers Licenses will be given by appointment only at 402-329-4810 on TUESDAYS ONLY.

The Governor has waived the renewal of driver's licenses and vehicle licensing.

Real Estate and Personal Property Taxes are due to the Pierce County Treasurer on or before April 30th, 2020. Please mail installments or use the Drop Box. Partial payments will not be accepted, Full 1st Half installments must be received. There is NO extensions on property taxes.

Pierce County Officials want to provide the safest environment as possible for employees and people who are inside the courthouse conducting business. In accordance with the Governor's recommendations we will not allow more than 10 people to congregate in open areas throughout County offices and spaces.

Pierce County Officials will monitor the ongoing COVID-19 Pandemic guidelines daily and make adjustments to our business practices and services to the public as needed. Thank You for understanding and patience during these very challenging circumstances.

There is drop box being installed soon and it will be at the southwest door for the Public to use.
